



**Grundtvig Partnership 2013 - 2015:  
“Engaging Disadvantaged Parents To Acquire Parenting Skills“**

**FRANKFURT MEETING REPORT  
25 -28 June 2015, Frankfurt am Main**

**Thursday, 25 June 2015**

- After an arrival to Frankfurt a short meeting with the coordinators was held and organizational details during mobility were discussed.  
The meeting attended: 7 participants from Centrum Rozwoju Biznesu Sp. z o.o. - Poland, 4 participants from Save the Children Timisoara - Romania, 4 participants from The Esperia – Greece, 5 participants from Çanakkale Halk Eğitimi ve ASO Müdürlüğü – Turkey, 3 participants from EURO-NET – Italy, 3 participants from NGO PROSCOALAVARIAS – Romania. Meeting was coordinated by 2 participants from host organisation Kroatische Wirtschaftsvereinigung e.V. – Germany.
- In the evening host organisation organised Welcome dinner for project’s participants in modern Frankfurt restaurant “Erbgut” in old and historical part of city, named Sachsenhausen. Participants had the chance to get to know each other and to share their contacts in relaxed non-working atmosphere.

**Friday, 26 June 2015**

- Participants visited Vocational Education Fair – Vocation park organized in Frankfurt city center where some of most perspective and needed occupations in Germany were presented e.g. soldier, roofer, hydraulic engineer, voluntary services, carpenter, joiner merchant retailer, state-recognized kindergarten teacher, boat master / skipper, florist, electrician, fashion designer etc.

**Results:**

With this activity one of the concrete partnership objectives stated in the application form was met: - to know new training opportunities for students in order to integrate into the European labour market.

Participants got familiarized with German labour market and educational system which could be very helpful in counselling and guiding their pupils and their parents in choosing future carrier and in their better integration into European labour market.

- After visiting Vocational Education Fair, one more participants’ meeting was held in the Conference room at Eintracht Frankfurt Sport center where local activities of each partner conducted from 2013 - 2015 were presented in order to fulfill project’s objectives:

- President of Kroatische Wirtschaftsvereinigung, Mr Mario Susak presented German educational system and its scope of work with the insight into educational possibilities for foreigners in Germany
  - Ms Natalija Cickovic (Kroatische Wirtschaftsvereinigung) made presentation: “*Path to follow for a successful professional orientation – German Experience*”. Vocational oriented activities, best practice examples and family role in professional orientation of a child were shared to the project partners.
  - Ms Vasiliki- Aliko Kalogianni (The Esperia) made presentation about Greek local activity conducted in cooperation with a layer: “*We are parents. Rights and Responsibilities*”. This activity was in accordance with one of the project’s aims: - importance for parents to realize children's rights, needs and principles of the normal development and parents responsibility to meet these needs.
  - Meeting continued with the presentations of Ms Anna Radon (Centrum Rozwoju Biznesu Sp. z o.o.), Mr Cristian Badi (Save the Children Timisoara), Ms Nursen Dinçer and Ms Ümmet Ceylan (Çanakkale Halk Eğitimi ve ASO Müdürlüğü), Mr Giuliano Bartolomei (EURO-NET) and finished with presentation of Ms Daniela Dragomir (NGO PROSCOALAVARIAS). Partners shared to each other the information about all local and transnational activities conducted in the last two years. Presentations gave us the complete project’s picture with its effects and results important for it’s successful completion.
- In the afternoon participants visited Mother and Family Center Bergen-Enkheim e.V. / Mütter- und Familienzentrum Bergen-Enkheim e.V. (MATZ)  
Ms Monika Adzamic, member of board, introduced the organisation to participants and presented weekly workshops of CROMAD with the aim to foster closer relationship between parents and children with Croatian migrant background.  
CROMAD workshop is local activity supported by Kroatische Wirtschaftsvereinigung in the frame of project “Engaging Disadvantaged Parents To Acquire Parenting Skills“. It is a practical example of project’s aim “How to improve my relationship with my child“.

### **Saturday, 27 June 2015**

- In the morning a short meeting in the Kroatische wirtschaftsvereinigung e.V., Brönnestraße 17, was held only for the representative of each partner.

#### Results:

Frankfurt meeting activities were evaluated. Participants gave their feedback about the organization (programme, accommodation, cultural events etc.) An open discussion on above topics took place.

- At noon, for participants was organized Frankfurt sightseeing tour with the professional guiding. During two hours by foot participants had the possibility to learn a little about Frankfurt’s history and to see old Frankfurt City Hall Römer, Frankfurt Cathedral St. Bartholomeus, Paul Church where first German constitution was made, old bridges, J. W. Goethe’s House, Frankfurt Stock Exchange, Old Opera House etc.
- In the afternoon a final meeting was held. The main topic was how to prepare a final report. An open discussion was held and after questions on this project’s topic, the coordinator gave the guidelines to partners for making the final report. Participants shared tasks and responsibilities in order to finish the project. Deadlines for next activities and for loading information in ECAS, on project’s web page were set. The plan for project’s visibility was discussed and agreed.

- In the evening a Goodbye dinner was held in old traditional restaurant “Zu den 12 Aposteln”. The representatives of the host organisation shared the Certificate of attendance to partners.
